- That on March 23rd, 2007, Town Council Privatized your Water Treatment Plant at a cost of \$1.25 million?
- That Sackville has Water Department employees capable and willing to train to the levels required by the province, but were consistently denied this opportunity (up to and including the time Council made the decision to privatize your water treatment plant)?
- That the Caustic Soda portion of the Plant sat idle from the time it was built, and for the next nine years, because the Town didn't have employees trained to operate it and they refused to train their employees to properly apply it?
- That applying Caustic Soda to the water supply was primarily all it took to clarify your water?
- That Water Department employees requested training to properly apply the Caustic Soda to Sackville's water for years, but were consistently told that it was not required?
- That \$1.25 million would pay the salary of a qualified Sackville Treatment Plant employee for 26 years?
