WORKSHOP A – STEWARD LEARNING SERIES (SLS) – (day and ½)

These three-hour modules will give stewards a wide range of knowledge and skills to represent members and respond to situations in the workplace. 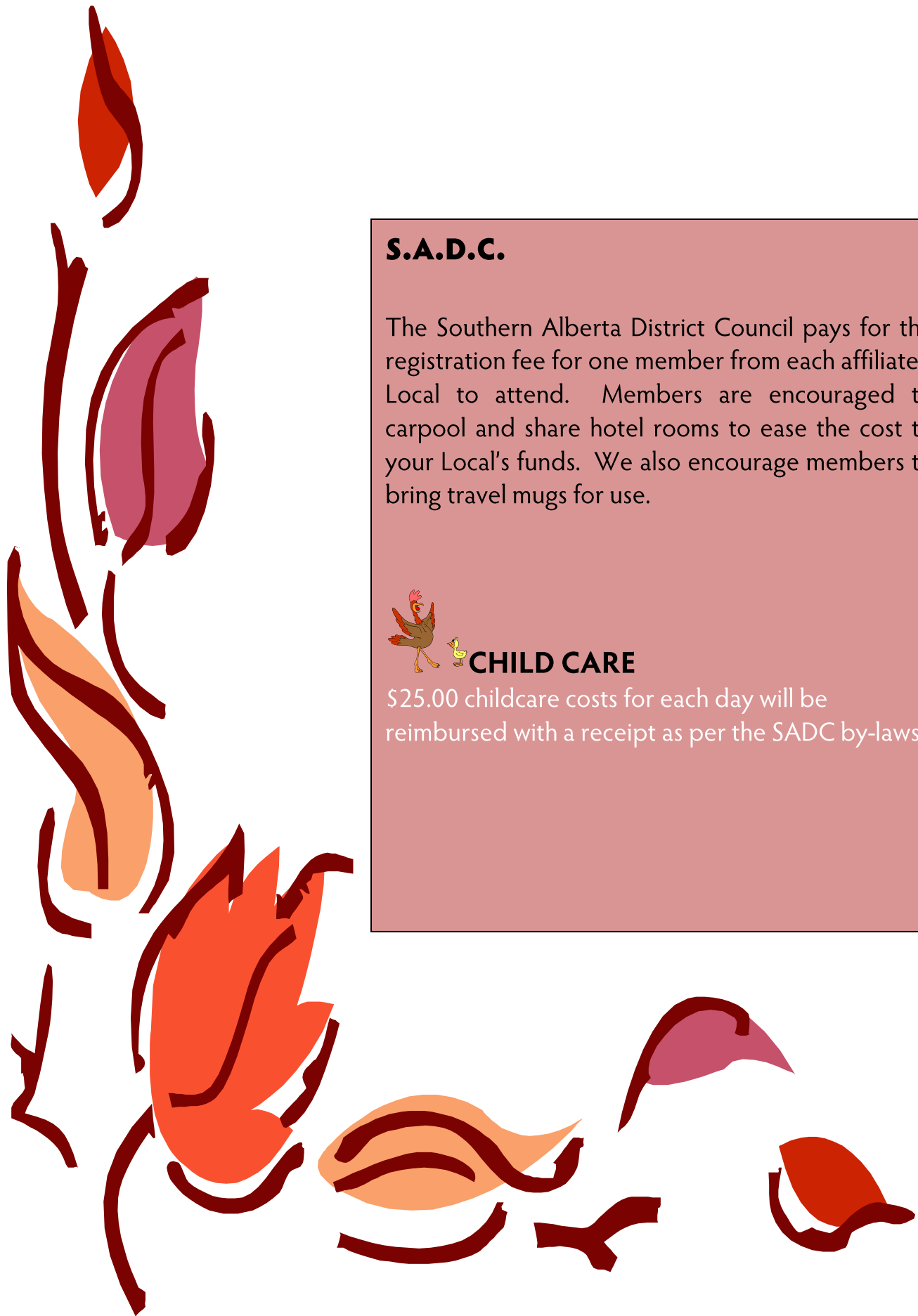
