

# ATTENTION TAXPAYERS:

Don't let Council drain away our assets!

Edmonton City Council has proposed to transfer the Gold Bar Waste Water Treatment Plant to EPCOR. The City will review the benefits and risks of this takeover and provide a report to Council on October 29th.

This is contrary to a decision made by Council three years ago with full public debate.

**The Gold Bar Waste Water Treatment plant is a public utility owned and operated by the City of Edmonton tax payers - it is our plant.**

This transfer could mean higher fees, less service, less oversight, and less accountability.

**The proposal is not transparent, and Council is not allowing public input or debate.**
