


Apply for the **KEALEY CUMMINGS SCHOLARSHIP** *for* **Labour College**



Brother Kealey Cummings was one of the students in the first Labour College of Canada class, held in 1963.

Kealey was a “founding father” of CUPE. As vice-president from the Ontario Hydro local of the National Union of Public Service Employees, he helped form CUPE. He served as our National Secretary-Treasurer from 1975-1985. In addition to his commitment to CUPE, Kealey has supported the College as an active alumni for fifty years.

To honour the achievements of all the students who have attended Labour College in the last 50 years, CUPE National has established the Kealey Cummings Scholarship.
