We are very excited about this initiative as it builds on our major strategic policy paper from our 2005 National Convention.

Meeting and Accommodation:

The meeting will be held at the Marriott Ottawa, 100 Kent Street, Ottawa K1P 5R7.

NOTE: The Marriott Ottawa is a non-smoking property. Smoking is not permitted on the premises or in any of the guest rooms.

Hotel Reservations:
