# Why are Saskatoon Public Library workers paid so poorly?

## The Saskatoon Public Library is a place where our community gathers.

From newcomers to lifelong learners, the dedicated staff at the public library – members of CUPE 2669 – help residents connect, imagine and navigate the digital world.

## But the Library Board doesn't seem to appreciate their work.

One in every three of these library workers earns about \$10 or less an hour. They receive few, if any, benefits.

In contrast, the managers at the Saskatoon library, who already enjoy generous salaries, received big pay increases in recent years.

## Why the double standard?

Why is the Library Board providing hefty increases to managers but refusing to give a decent increase to Kim Searle and the 250 other CUPE library workers?

## Urge the Library Board to negotiate a fair wage increase. It's overdue.
