NELSON FACTS OF SHAME

- A Nelson senior administrators are the highest paid in the Kootenays, making up to \$10,000 a year more than administrators in Trail.
- **B** In 2000, Nelson senior staff gave themselves up to 20% wage increases worth over \$100,000, while city workers got no wage increase.
- Nelson city workers make on average \$45,000 a year – that's half of management's average wage.
- In the past 10 years, Nelson residents have lost 33 city workers, while management has grown.

We welcome the assistance of Mediator Vince Ready on Monday, June 28th, 2004 to end the lockout and negotiate a fair collective agreement.

We urge Mayor David Elliott and City Councillors to respect the needs and wishes of Nelson city residents.
