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




Economy recovering, but growth to be slower

Actual and Forecast 1982 - 2030










Record deficit, gradual return to balance.












But deficit situation less severe than 1990s






Growth of revenues and program spending to slow






Gains for public sector workers in recent years








Public sector wages only recently recovered from cuts of 1990s

(adjusted for inflation 1992 = 100%)






Real wages calculated using Ontario Ministry of Labour annual base wage increases from collective agreements for Ontario, adjusted for inflation using Ontario CPI.






Wage bill declining share of public spending

Ontario Debt Reduction Profiles





Annual costs of corporate tax cuts and savings from proposed Ontario public sector wage freeze








Cuts to public spending to fund tax cuts will hurt the economy

(per \$1 Million invested or spent)





Ontario combined federal-provincial corporate tax rates and business investment in machinery and equipment








Ontario program spending relatively low







Total Canadian government revenue as share of economy (GDP)










School age population and enrolment declining
