Working far below expectations and ability. Many support staff have been the victim of violent incidents at school. The zero tolerance policies must be implemented and adhered to for all students and staff to create and maintain a positive learning and working environment.	Demonstrates lack of understanding and frequently inattentive
Training & Professional Development:	
Needs considerable improvement. Inconsistent in outcomes. More effort is needed to provide quality, relevant professional development and training for all support staff.	More study recommended
Working Conditions:	
More attention to detail required. Improving the working conditions of Support Staff also improves the quality of learning for students and a better working environment for staff. More study in this subject is recommended.	Not working to full potential
Respect:	
More focus is required. Must do better in this subject area! Understanding and respecting the work and important contribution of Support Staff is essential. Lack of knowledge of weak areas hinders progress.	Finds subject difficult Doesn't work well with support staff – Improvement required!
