REGISTRATION FOR DIVERSITY VICE-PRESIDENT ELECTION CAUCUSES



National Convention elects two Diversity Vice-President (DVP) positions on CUPE's National Executive Board, one representing Black and racialized workers and the other representing Indigenous workers.

These positions will be elected in the DVP Election Caucuses. Delegates will now be automatically registered for the caucuses if they identify as Black, racialized or Indigenous on the email sent to them during the registration process.

Registration for these caucuses will also be available at National Convention in the registration hall, at the information booth, and outside the caucus rooms beginning an hour before the caucuses, for those who didn't self-identify while registering.

Black, racialized and Indigenous members who intend to vote in the DVP Election Caucuses must be delegates with full credentials to the National Convention and identify as Black, racialized or Indigenous. An alternate delegate can vote in a DVP Election Caucus only when replacing a delegate from the same chartered organization and only if in possession of that delegate's badge. The alternate must also self-identify as Black, racialized or Indigenous.
